The 'triple lock' refers to the approval by Irish government, Dáil, and UN Security Council before more than 12 Irish soldiers are deployed in an operation overseas. It is not perfect. But the proposal by the Minister for Foreign Affairs and for Defence to substitute something else would be meaningless – e.g. the EU to approve an EU military operation. Defend Irish neutrality! Work for peace not the perpetuation of war!
